RL 7.1 Cite several pieces of textual evidence to support analysis of what the text says explicitly as well as inferences drawn from the text.

Why do the Stasi keep a watchful eye on Gerta and her family? Cite evidence from the novel to support your answer.

On page 69, Gerta says, "In the days since coming back from the Stasi, something about Fritz had changed." How has Fritz changed? What can we infer are the reasons for his change?

RL 7.3 Analyze how particular elements of a story or drama interact

The setting in *A Night Divided* is a major part of the story. Choose two characters from the novel and describe how living on the East side of the Berlin Wall affected them. How did Gerta deal with the affects differently than her mother?

Summary: A Night Divided takes place in Berlin, Germany when the Berlin Wall was built in 1961. Gerta, a twelve-yearold girl, was separated from her father and middle brother when the wall went up overnight. Gerta lives with her mother and oldest brother on the Eastern side of Berlin, the side controlled by the Soviets. Life on the East Side of Berlin is not easy. Gerta must get to the West Side and reconnect her family. A Night Divided is a story about family and the courage to fight for one's freedom
